

Eucalyptus oil / Eucalyptol

As a result of the implementation of the policy of returning forests to cultivation, farmers have reduced their plantations of such crops, leading to a significant reduction in the area under forestry. Compared with the previous two years, few farmers are now engaged in oil distillations. Although the yield has remained at a normal level, the labor cost for distillation has been rising as most young and strong labors choose to go out to work. As a result, farmers prefer to sell the existing oil in their hands first to reduce the financial pressure, so the overall stock

level is also decreasing.



Geranium oil

Geranium oil has just passed its production season, however, this year's climatic conditions were quite dry with low temperatures, which adversely affected the oil distillation, resulting in a significant drop in oil yield and a relatively low content of active ingredients in the oil. Nonetheless, farmers still have a certain amount of stocks on hand, which are generally lower than the market demand. Prices for these stocks are continuing to rise due to supply and demand.




Citronella oil

In contrast to the previous two years, the planting area of Citronella oil has decreased a lot because of the increased external demand. The market price of Citronella oil in Luchun County, Honghe City, is high, and although there is quite a lot of oil, farmers are reluctant to make a move, wanting to wait until the price is higher; Yingjiang has a relatively small area under cultivation, but there are imports of citronella oil from Burma, and the overall volume of oil is tight, with demand outstripping supply.


Wintergreen oil

This year's planting is small thus the output of star anise oil has not changed much compared with last year, stock is still there and the price has no tendency to rise, supply on the market is relatively stable.





Litsea cubeba oil /Citral

There is still enough inventory to supply, everyone is also expecting a rising market according to the rhythm of previous years, the lower the inventory, the higher the price.

Litsea cubeba production has reduced by 40% -50% this year, equivalent to the output of about 500MT less, but due to the climate is suitable, the production of Litsea cubeba and the yield has not changed much, the price is lower, but also led to many farmers to reduce the planting, But there will be a situation of high demand

in the future, which will lead to a shortage of inventory .


